

Policy for the Safeguarding of Vulnerable Adults for the Church Council of The Church in Warden Hill
Reviewed in accordance with the Diocesan Policy and adopted by Ecumenical Church Council on 06.02.20.

This policy will be reviewed each year to monitor the progress which has been achieved and a copy shared with the Archdeacon at the time of the Visitation.

1. The Ecumenical Church Council (ECC) adopts the guidelines of the Church of England and the Diocese of Gloucester.
2. As members of this church, we recognise that everyone has different levels of vulnerability and that each of us may be regarded as vulnerable at some time in our lives.
3. We commit ourselves to respectful pastoral care for all adults to whom we minister.
4. We commit ourselves to the safeguarding of people who may be vulnerable, ensuring their well-being in the life of this church.
5. We commit ourselves to promoting safe practice by those in positions of trust.
6. We commit ourselves to promoting the inclusion and empowerment of people who may be vulnerable.
7. It is the responsibility of each of us to prevent the physical, emotional, sexual, financial and spiritual abuse of vulnerable people and to report any such abuse that we discover or suspect.
8. We undertake to exercise proper care in the appointment and selection of those who will work with people who may be vulnerable.
9. The church is committed to supporting, resourcing, training and regularly reviewing those who undertake work amongst people who may be vulnerable.
10. Each person who works with vulnerable people will agree to abide by these recommendations and the guidelines.
